BA in History–Secondary Teaching

The Department of Geography, Sociology, History, African-American Studies, and Anthropology offers a Bachelor of Arts degree in History and Africana Studies and a minor in History and Africana Studies for students majoring in other disciplines. All department majors must complete the assessment requirements specific to their major field, copies of which can be obtained from the departmental website.

The department's Bachelor of Arts degree in History and Africana Studies consists of three options: Liberal Arts Option in History, Liberal Arts Option in Africana Studies, and Secondary Teaching Option in History. Completion of the Secondary Teaching Option in History qualifies students for an Initial Illinois Professional Educator License (PE) with an endorsement for teaching Social Studies for grades 9-12. Teaching licensure requires the successful completion of Social Studies with History content area test and edTPA.
