## Degrees Available at CSU: Bachelor of Science in Education • Elementary Education

The Department of Education Studies at Chicago State University provides our diverse student population with a rigorous broad curriculum that prepares students for professional careers, graduate work or employment in public and private school and nonschool educational settings at the elementary primary and intermediate level. This degree leads to an initial Professional Educator Licensure (PEL) in Elementary Education (grades 1 to 6) upon successful completion of the program along with a passing score on the Illinois Licensure Testing System (ILTS) examination (Test 305) and the edTPA Candidate Work Sample Portfolio project. Candidates choose one of two endorsement areas: Reading Teacher and English as Second Language.

## **Admission Requirements:**

This program is designed for students who have an AA or AAS degree. Students seeking admissions must apply through the Admissions Office and meet with the Education Studies Department Undergraduate Advisor. Transfer students must complete the same procedures through the Admissions Office. All incoming Freshmen must take Placement Exams. Start your admissions application through this link.

General Education and Prerequisite Requirements: General Education Requirements will be waived for candidates with an earned A.A. or A.S. degree from an accredited college. Candidates without an A.A. or A.S. degree are required to complete the following general education prerequisites: ENG 1260, 1270, 1280, CMAT 1130 or 2030, ART 1100 or 2600, Humanities Elective or MUS 1134, BIOL 1510 or 1070, Ph SCI 1100 or 1130 and 1140 or 1150 or GEOG 1400, GEOG 1100, HIST 1310 or 1300, ECON 1010 and 1020, POLS 1010, MATH 1200. Candidates may take the CLEP exam for applicable courses.
