



College of Education Admission Requirements

For Master's Degree Initial Teacher Certification Programs

Admission to the College of Education (COE) is granted only to students majoring in a teacher education program. Applicants must have a program application with proof of their bachelor's degree on file in their department. State law requires that teacher certificates are issued only to individuals who are either citizens of the United States or foreign nationals who are legally present and authorized for employment by the Immigration and Naturalization Service. If you receive a certificate and you are not a citizen, you have ten years from the issue date of the certificate to become a United States Citizen. By law, if you fail to become a citizen within the ten year period, your certificate must be cancelled.

STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

1. **GENERAL EDUCATION:** Applicants must be within 12 hours of completing the general education course requirements in their program by the end of the term prior to admission.
2. **GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)/GRADES:** Master's Degree applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4-point scale in the final 60 hours of their bachelor's degree courses, and a minimum grade of "C" in courses satisfying general education requirements. MAT applicants must also have a minimum grade of C and a GPA of 3.0 in 18 hours of courses beyond the introductory level and at the 200 level or above in a 32-hour major. This major must be in the teaching area for Secondary and K-12 MAT programs. In addition, successful grades are required in all required courses attempted prior to admission to the COE. A minimum GPA of 3.0 must be maintained in the master's degree program.
3. **Entrance Examinations:**
 - a. Illinois Certification Test of Basic Skills (ICTBS): passing score within the last nine (9) years. Please see the exam schedule at www.icts.nesinc.com for registration information and deadlines.
 - b. Illinois Language Proficiency Test (TLP): passing score (within the last nine years) or a Type 29 Transitional Bilingual Certificate is required for admission in the Bilingual Education program.
4. **Recommendations:** All applicants must obtain two (2) recommendations for admission to the COE: one from the student's academic department and one personal reference from outside the university.
5. **TRANSCRIPTS:** Post Baccalaureate students must attach two updated official transcripts for courses completed after beginning a teacher certification program at CSU. If updated official transcripts have already been submitted to the Office of Teacher Certification (OTC) in ED 208, the student may skip this step.
6. **Professional Code of Conduct:** Applicants must not have any unresolved violations of the Professional Code of Conduct at the time of admission to the College of Education. Please see the Professional Code of Conduct Policy at www.csu.edu/collegeofeducation/.
7. **Laptop Computer Policy:** Applicants must own or have access to a laptop computer for class use, effective Spring 2007. Visit www.csu.edu/collegeofeducation/to link to websites for discounts on laptop computers.
