Scholarship Criteria

Applicants Must:

1. be admitted to and/or enrolled at Chicago State University; undergraduate/graduate CSU students must be currently enrolled for at-least 6 credit hours.
2. be Latino or of Latino descent (Latino father and/or mother)*
3. provide copy of transcripts from schools previously attended
 - freshmen must have at least an 18 in the ACT
 - all freshmen must provide high school transcripts
 - transfer students must have at least 24 credit hours
4. have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale as of July 31, 2010
5. demonstrate involvement in extra curricular activities/community service

Scholarship Specifics

Complete application packet will consist of the following materials:

- Application
- 500 word essay/personal statement
- Copy of Transcripts (official/unofficial)
- Résumé (for continuing/graduate and transfer students only)
- Two letters of recommendation. These letters should be from teachers/professors, supervisors, or individuals from your community who can speak about your community involvement and are not related to you.

In preparing your essay/personal statement, please select one of following questions:

1. What has been your biggest personal challenge? How have you overcome or met this challenge?
2. What would you say are your greatest qualities or accomplishments?
3. What are your future goals as they relate to your educational and career plans?
4. How would you contribute to the well being of the Latino community at Chicago State University as a recipient of the Latino Resource Center Scholarship?
5. What does it mean to you to be Latino?

- Selected scholarship recipients are required to provide 20 hours of community service to the Latino Resource Center during the awarded academic year; **failure to comply will disqualify you from future LRC Scholarships.**
- Scholarship recipients will be announced during the Scholarship Banquet on August 2010 and **ALL** recipients are required to attend.
- One free ticket will be made available to each scholarship recipient
