

Under 504, an institution may not:

- make preadmission inquiries as to whether an applicant has a disability;
- limit the number of students with disabilities admitted;
- use admission standards that have the effect of discriminating on the basis of disability;
- use admission tests or criteria that inadequately measure the academic qualifications of students with disabilities because special provisions were not made;
- restrict enrollment into certain colleges or majors based on disability;
- exclude a student with a disability from a course of study;
- counsel a student with a disability toward a more restrictive career;
- measure student achievement using modes that adversely discriminate against a student with a disability;
- establish rules and policies that may adversely affect students with disabilities.
