

Admissions Information and Application Procedures

High School juniors and seniors who are in good standing can have the opportunity to earn college credits by attending Chicago State University as a High School-at-Large (Visiting) student. Participating students may register for one lower-division course per semester. In order to be admitted to the university, students must complete the High School-at-Large application and submit the following requirements:

- **High School transcript** – (minimum required GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale)
- **ACT/SAT score** (strongly recommended but not required)
- **Letter of recommendation** from a school counselor
- **Personal statement** – *discuss your interest in a college readiness program and its impact on your educational goals*
- **\$25 Application fee**

The application and documents can be mailed to the Office of Admissions at the address below or scanned (not photographed) and sent via email to: ug-admissions@csu.edu Once the application is completed and reviewed, the University will confirm an admission decision via mail and email.
