

COLLEGE OF EDUCATION ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

For Undergraduate and Non-Degree Post-Baccalaureate

Initial Teacher Certification Programs

ADMISSION TO THE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION (COE) IS GRANTED ONLY TO STUDENTS MAJORING IN A TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM. NON-DEGREE APPLICANTS MUST HAVE A PROGRAM APPLICATION WITH PROOF OF THEIR BACHELOR'S DEGREE ON FILE IN THEIR ACADEMIC DEPARTMENT. STATE LAW REQUIRES THAT TEACHER CERTIFICATES ARE ISSUED ONLY TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE EITHER CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES OR FOREIGN NATIONALS WHO ARE LEGALLY PRESENT AND AUTHORIZED FOR EMPLOYMENT BY THE IMMIGRATION AND NATURALIZATION SERVICE. IF YOU RECEIVE A CERTIFICATE AND YOU ARE NOT A CITIZEN, YOU HAVE TEN YEARS FROM THE ISSUE DATE OF THE CERTIFICATE TO BECOME A UNITED STATES CITIZEN. BY LAW, IF YOU FAIL TO BECOME A CITIZEN WITHIN THE TEN YEAR PERIOD, YOUR CERTIFICATE MUST BE CANCELLED.

STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

1. **GENERAL EDUCATION:** Applicants cannot be lacking more than 12 hours in their program's course requirements in general education by the end of the term prior to admission.
2. **GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)/GRADES:** Undergraduate and Non-Degree Post Baccalaureate applicants must have a minimum Program GPA of 2.5 in all courses satisfying degree requirements in the three areas of general education, professional education, and the area of specialization or concentration, including transfer credit and courses completed at Chicago State University. In addition, successful grades are required in all required courses attempted prior to admission to the COE. For admission to student teaching, graduation, and a recommendation for certification, a minimum GPA of 2.5 is required in the following: all courses required in the program (Program GPA); all courses in the area of specialization or concentration; and all courses in professional education. (Some programs have higher GPA requirements.) A CSU cumulative GPA of 2.0 in all courses completed at CSU is required for undergraduate graduation.
3. **ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS:**
 - a. **Illinois Certification Test of Basic Skills (ICTBS)** within the last nine (9) years. Please see the exam schedule at www.icts.nesinc.com for registration information and deadlines.
 - b. **For Undergraduates only (who did not pass the ICTBS prior to admission to CSU in an education major):**
 - a. Qualifying Exam in English Composition (or ENG 095, 124 or 128/1280);
 - b. Qualifying Exam in Reading (or READ 101, 090, or 150/1500);
 - c. Qualifying Exam in Mathematics;
 - d. If admitted or re-admitted to the university Fall 98 or after: Math Exam (PPP) or Math 099/0990, 098 or 160.
 - e. If admitted or re-admitted to the university before Fall 98: Math Exam (PP) or Math 095 (completed before Fall 98), 098, 104, 120, 139, or 160.
 - c. **Bilingual Education majors** must pass the **Illinois Language Proficiency Test (TLP) within the last nine (9) years.**
4. **RECOMMENDATIONS:** All applicants must obtain two (2) recommendations for admission to the COE: one from the student's academic department and one personal reference from outside the university.
5. **TRANSCRIPTS:** Undergraduate students must attach one official transcript from each college and university attended except Chicago State University. Post Baccalaureate students must attach two updated official transcripts for courses completed after beginning a teacher certification program at CSU. If updated official transcripts have already been submitted to the Certification Counselor in the academic department, the student may skip this step.
6. **PROFESSIONAL CODE OF CONDUCT:** Applicants must not have any unresolved violations of the Professional Code of Conduct at the time of admission to the College of Education. Please see the Professional Code of Conduct Policy at www.csu.edu/collegeofeducation/ .
7. **LAPTOP COMPUTER POLICY:** Applicants must own or have access to a laptop computer for class use, effective Spring 2007. Visit www.csu.edu/collegeofeducation/ to link to websites for discounts on laptop computers.
8. **BACKGROUND CHECK:** Applicants must turn in a copy of a "cleared" fingerprint background check. The applicant is responsible for all costs associated with the fingerprint background check.

Definitions of Redefined Race Groups according to federal and state reporting guidelines:
