#### Degrees Available at CSU: Master of Arts in Education Leadership and Administration • PreK-Age 22 Principal Licensure (PRIN)

The Department of Advanced Studies in Education at Chicago State University offers programs to prepare students for roles as elementary or secondary school principals or assistant principals. Options include:

- MA in Educational Leadership and Administration with PreK-Age 22 Principal Licensure (PRIN): Leads to both the M.A. degree and the PreK-Age 22 endorsement on an Illinois Professional Educator License (subtest 195 and 196).
- Principal Licensure Only (ELPP): Leads to a principal license (only) on a Professional Educator License: Requires completion
  of the Training in Evaluation of Certified Personnel and passing Content Area Tests for Principals (subtests 195 and 196).

#### **Admission Requirements:**

Official transcripts from all institutions previously attended (excluding CSU) are required. 3.0 GPA (on a 4-point grading scale) required for full admission; 2.75 GPA for conditional admittance.
