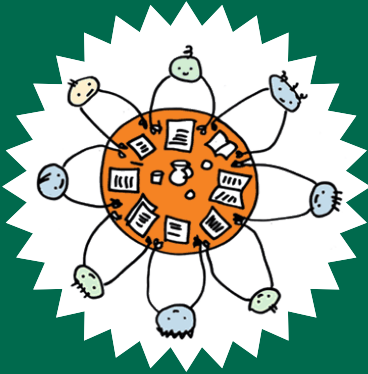

"The Authentic Assessment Toolbox" Workshop

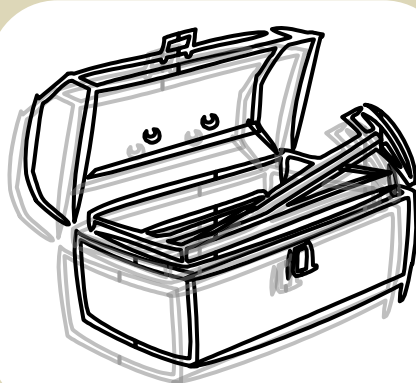
with Dr. Jon Mueller, Professor of Psychology, North Central College
