## Cabell's Directories

Cabell's Directories is intended to assist faculty and researchers in matching their manuscripts with the right journals. It provides valuable information for each journal listed within its pages. The journal information provided includes publication addresses, contact



information, websites for listed journals, and links to guidelines and submission information. *Cabell's* also includes information on the style and format of the journals and indicates what citation style the journals employ.

Furthermore, *Cabell's* describes the type of review process used by editor(s), number of reviewers, acceptance rate, time required for review, availability of reviewers' comments, number of copies required, and manuscript topics.
