The next offering of CSU's Online Certification Training (OCT) course will begin June 24.

OCT prepares CSU faculty to effectively teach online courses by exploring the following topics:

- What is online teaching?
- Best practices
- Copyright and fair use
- Instructional design basics
- Building online content

The eight-week course is completely online, and those who successfully meet all of its requirements are provided with a certificate of completion.

In accordance with Appendix G of the <u>2010-2015 CSU Contract</u>, faculty must complete OCT in order to teach online at CSU.

Moodle Upgrade Coming in August

This August, Chicago State University will be upgrading from Moodle 1.9 to Moodle 2.3.

The upgrade will afford students and faculty greater ease of use, flexibility, and functionality.

Training

In preparation for the upgrade, the CTRE will be facilitating hands-on training sessions for faculty throughout the summer, beginning June 10. These sessions will take place on two days per week, in morning, afternoon, and evening
