Moodle is set to be upgraded on August 26, and while there will not be any dramatic changes to how it is used, some new activities will be added that you may want to try out:

1) Big Blue Button

This is a web conferencing system that is about as simple as it gets. Share desktop screens and presentations, use a whiteboard, and record sessions. <u>Click here</u> to learn more.

2) Q & A Forum

This is a new optional setting in the forum activity which makes it so that students don't see anyone else's

discussion posts until they've submitted their first one. <u>Click here</u> to learn more.

3) Workshop

Transfer Process




