The Illinois Department of Human Services, Office of Grants Administration is currently offering "On-Line Training in Grant Writing" to assist individuals with their grant writing efforts.

This three-part online training—which

### New Login Page for Turnitin.com

In early January, Turnitin will be making a change to its website, replacing the "Sign In" fields at the top of each webpage with a "Log In" button. Clicking the "Log In" button will take users to a new login page where they can log in with their email address and password. This change will not impact users accessing Turnitin via an LMS integration.

Users can bookmark this new login page which will load faster and provide quick links to helpful resources.


