Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy for Doctor of Pharmacy Candidates

The College of Pharmacy will provide the Office of Student Financial Aid with documentation at the end of each academic term evidencing the progress of all students with respect to the College of Pharmacy Satisfactory Academic Policy. For informational purpose said policy is incorporated as part of this **Chicago State University Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy for Doctor of Pharmacy Candidates.**

College of Pharmacy Satisfactory Academic Policy

Academic Standing

A student must maintain a professional year grade point average of 2.00 in the professional program to remain in good academic standing.

A student is placed on academic probation for any of the following reasons:

- 1) A student's professional year grade point average falls below 2.00
- 2) A student earns a grade of F in one or more courses
- 3) A student earns a D in two or more courses

A student is notified, in writing, that he/she is being placed on academic probation. Academic probation represents notice that continued inadequate academic performance may result in dismissal from the College.

If the student is placed on academic probation, the Student Promotion and Graduation Committee will determine actions to return the student to good academic standing. These may include but are not limited to:

- 1) Completion of remedial work
- 2) Repeat of the course(s)

In addition to the above actions, the Student Promotion and Graduation Committee may determine that the student should be dismissed from the college.

Any student not in compliance with the College of Pharmacy Satisfactory Academic Policy shall also be considered to be non-compliant with the **Chicago State University Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy for Doctor of Pharmacy Candidates.** All such students will be ineligible for financial aid funds/loans for all subsequent academic terms until which time that he/she either:

comes back into compliance with the **Chicago State University Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy for Doctor of Pharmacy Candidates,** or

petitions for reinstatement of financial aid eligibility and has said petition approved by the Financial Aid Appeals Board of the Office of Student Financial Aid.
