The cues for teacher certification are shared between the College of Education and the College of Arts and Sciences. Department chairs must discuss that division as in the past. Permission to round to the closest number is permitted, e.g., 1.26 = 1.25, 1.48 = 1.5, 2.04 = 2, or 1.89 = 2 cues.
