APPLY TO CSU

FRESHMEN REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. A completed application
- 2. Official transcripts from all high schools attended or official GED Report
- 3. Official SAT/ACT Scores*
- 4. No application fee
- 5. A letter of recommendation

4 years English

3 years Math: Algebra I & II; Geometry

3 years Science including 2 years Lab

3 years Social Science

2 years Foreign language, vocational education or art

SUCCESS U.: AN OPTIONAL PATHWAY TO ADMISSIONS

Applicants who do not meet one or more of the admissions criteria may be eligible for conditional fall admission via Success U.

Success U is designed to help students gain the skills to strengthen their academic performance during the first year of college and beyond.

This program requires a student to be admitted and the successful completion of a six-week summer bridge program.

TRANSFER TO CSU

TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. A completed application
- Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended (For applicants with less than 24 semester hours of college-level course work, high school transcript or GED Test Report and SAT/ACT scores are required for consideration for admissions).
- 3. A minimum grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 grading scale is required for all transfer students.
- 4. No application fee

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Applicants seeking transfer admissions into the university will be considered if they have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale (a higher grade point average may be required for admission into specific programs such as nursing, occupational therapy). Transfer applicants with less than 24 semester hours of collegelevel course work must also meet freshmen admissions requirements.

UNDOCUMENTED APPLICANTS:


Undocumented applicants who graduate from high school and have been admitted to Chicago State University can qualify for in-state tuition by completing an affidavit.

HONORS COLLEGE

The Honors College at Chicago State recruits academically-talented students who have demonstrated leadership ability, service, and maintained a high cumulative grade point average in their high school and/or college courses. Students admitted into the Honors College take an academically rigorous and enriched general education curriculum, participate in campus and community service activities, and receive scholarship support for their tuition and mandatory fees.

Students must apply directly to the Honors College and meet the academic criteria for admission to the Honors College, as well as provide letters of recommendation and a specific personal statement.

2020-21 ADMISSIONS UPDATES

CSU no longer requires application fees for applicants and has adopted a partial test-optional policy. Students with a GPA of 2.75 or higher, are not required to submit their SAT or ACT scores for consideration of admission to CSU.

AIM HIGH CSU SCHOLARSHIP


