English Language Proficiency

International applicants whose native language is not English must present evidence of proficiency in oral and written English by obtaining a satisfactory score on the Test of English as Foreign Language (TOEFL). The TOEFL code for CSU is 1118.

International applicants are not subject to the CSU TOEFL/IELTS requirements if any of the following factors apply:

- a. The applicant completed secondary education in a country where the native or official language is English; **OR**
- b. The applicant completed secondary education at a institution where English was the medium of instruction; **OR**
- c. The applicant has completed a minimum of 24 semester hours or 36-quarter hours at an accredited U.S. College or university.

B. Evidence of Financial Support

- 1. Submit a completed **Financial Certificate of Sponsorship**. (Use enclosed form.)
- Furnish evidence, in the form of a letter from the bank or employer, indicating that monies (amount in U.S. dollars) are available to meet the financial needs of the student.
