The 3D Studio Art concentration produces artists committed to their work and prepared to succeed in the arts. Students discover and pursue their creative skills and interests in sculpture, ceramics, and fiber arts/weaving. Students also take courses in 2D studio art disciplines. An interdisciplinary approach to art making is strongly encouraged. This course of study provides a meaningful base for those wishing to pursue an art-related career, teaching artist position, graduate school, or a career in other creative areas. Frequent critiques, exhibitions of student work, and exposure to art, professional artists, and business practices promote professional development.

Admission Requirements: Students seeking admission to any degree program in Art & Design must apply through the Admissions Office and meet with the Art & Design Department Undergraduate Advisor. Transfer students must complete the same procedures through the Admissions Office. All incoming Freshmen must take Placement Exams.
