The Art Education Teacher Preparation curriculum is for students pursuing licensure as an art teacher. It exposes students to both the philosophy and methodology of art education and provides meaningful experiences in observation and practice teaching in the city and suburban schools. In addition, students are involved in a wide range of pre-teaching experiences and develop expertise in studio practice and art history. The successful completion of the art education option qualifies students for a Type 10 Illinois Professional Educator License for grades Pre-Kindergarten – 12 in the visual arts.

**Admission Requirements:** Students seeking admission to any degree program in Art & Design must apply through the Admissions Office and meet with the Art & Design Department Undergraduate Advisor. Transfer students must complete the same procedures through the Admissions Office. All incoming Freshmen must take Placement Exams.
