Degrees Available at CSU: Master of Science in Education • Special Education

The Department of Advanced Studies in Education at Chicago State University offers a comprehensive curriculum to prepare students as special education learning behavioral specialists or similar positions. The program provides three options:

- Special Education Learning Behavioral Specialist-I Master's Degree Program for Certified Teachers: Tailored for candidates with valid teaching licensure, typically in general education.
- Special Education Learning Behavioral Specialist-I Master's Degree Program for Initial Certification (Test 155): Designed for candidates new to teaching without a professional teaching license.
- Endorsement in Special Education Program Option: Available for licensed general education teachers seeking to add the Special Education Learning Behavioral Specialist -I (Test 155) endorsement to their existing license.

Completion of coursework, field experiences, and degree requirements in these options qualifies candidates for the Illinois Learning Behavioral Specialist - I (K-12) Professional Educator licensure and a Master of Science in Education Degree.

Admission Requirements:

To apply for admission to this program, candidates should visit the School of Graduate and Professional Studies website at https://www.csu.edu/graduateschool/ and follow the provided instructions to submit their application online. Official transcripts from all institutions previously attended (excluding CSU) are required. 3.0 GPA (on a 4-point grading scale) required for full admission; 2.75 GPA for conditional admittance.
