

The College of Health Sciences is proposing a guaranteed admission to the professional programs for first time freshman who declare Community Health, Health Information Administration, Nursing, Pre-Occupational Therapy and Pre-Physical Therapy as their major.

An admission seat is guaranteed into the designated undergraduate professional programs as long as the freshman enrolls at CSU and maintains the qualifying standards necessary for the guaranteed admission program.

Criteria for Admission to the Guaranteed Admission Program:

- High School completion
- ACT score of 23 or above
- SAT score of 1400 or above
- High School grade point average of 3.25 or higher unweighted
- Save 10 seats per each program

Criteria for enrolled students:

- Maintain cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above
- Participate in COHS academy leadership and service activities
- Institute a probation period for the academy
