December 1 – 12 Spring 2013 Intersession Course Registration period continues
Regular Spring 2013 Registration continues for Regular Session Courses and Special Session (12-week) courses. Students may add/drop 16-week (regular) and 12-week special session courses online during this period. See Quick View Chart (page 4, Spring 2013 Class Schedule Bulletin) for payment information.

Dec. 1 – Jan. 6 First E-Bill posted for Spring 2013. Subsequent E-Bills will be sent monthly. Check your CSU E-mail for notifications.

December 3 Validation Deadline for Intersession Course Registration: Initial payment due for Spring 2013 Intersession course registration before being dropped for non-payment.

December 12 Last day to register for Spring 2013 Intersession Courses

Dec. 12 – Jan. 12 Spring 2013 Intersession course period. Non-attendance withdrawals "WN" are due within two (2) days from the start of the intersession course.
Withdrawals for Intersession courses must be submitted within two (2) days from the start of the intersession course to receive 100% reversal of charges.

December 13 Non-payment drop/withdrawal date for students who have not made an initial payment for Spring 2013 intersession courses.

January 7 Validation Deadline: Initial payment due for Spring 2013 regular session registration before being dropped or withdrawn for non-payment.

January 7 Last day to select Cougar Cash Card as refund preference

January 7 – 15 Late registration / late change of program period for Regular Session (16-week) courses- (via CSU X-Press).
Any initial (first-time) registrations processed January 14 or later will incur a \$100 late registration fee.

January 10 – 12 Spring 2013 Book Vouchers (on CSU ID) and U-Pass distribution period

January 16 Final grades due for Spring 2013 Intersession courses

January 21 Deadline for enrollment in, or waiving out, of mandatory student health insurance program if enrolled in regular session (16-week) course(s)

January 21 HOLIDAY – Martin Luther King Jr.'s Birthday – No classes

January 22 Non-payment drop/withdrawal date for students who have not made an initial payment.

January 22 Last day for faculty to submit non-attendance "WN" withdrawals to the Office of the Registrar for 16-week courses.

January 22 Deadline for 100% reversal of refundable fees and tuition when registered for 15 hours or less or upon complete withdrawal from all courses.

January 22 See Complete Withdrawal Note at bottom of page.*

January 22 Deadline to submit proof of required immunizations to Wellness/Health Center to avoid \$25 non-compliance fee.

January 24 Last day to be reinstated after administrative withdrawal (non-payment and/or academic department withdrawal). Students will not be reinstated in closed courses.

February 2013

February 1 - 12 Special Session Registration continues. Special Session Change of Program Period. (Students may add/drop courses online during this period.)
Payment is due at time of registration.

February 8 Deadline to submit undergraduate and graduate graduation applications to academic advisors

February 8 Deadline to submit academic petitions for Fall 2012 term

February 11 - 12 Late registration / late change of program period via CSU X-Press for Special Session courses only.
Any initial (first-time) registrations processed February 11 or later will incur \$100 late registration fee.

February 11 First day of Special Session classes

February 11 – 16 Academic warning submission period

*NOTE: Students will not be able to drop the last class online, resulting in a full withdrawal with zero (0) credit hours of enrollment. Students must request and complete the "Complete Withdrawal Form" and submit it via the web to the Office of the Registrar (ADM 128) by 5pm, on the specified due date. He/she must also participate in a short in-person interview prior to the processing of the complete withdrawal by the Registrar's Office. See page 15 for more information.
