In response to the prevalence of the Omicron variant, **CSU will expand surveillance testing to include all students, faculty, and staff, regardless of vaccination status.**

Surveillance testing procedure

Beginning January 17, 2022, CSU will test 20% of our campus community each week to help monitor breakthrough and asymptomatic cases.

CSU students, faculty and staff will be notified when their test needs to take place and be submitted. The emails will be sent by coronavirus@csu.edu (for students) or hr@csu.edu (for faculty and staff). The deadline to complete the required COVID-19 test is by 12 pm on Friday.

Use of on-campus testing services required

To meet the surveillance testing requirement, students, faculty, and staff must utilize CSU's regular weekday COVID-19 testing. These PCR tests are free (no insurance needed), non-invasive, and take 10 minutes or less to complete. Testing will be closed on January 17 in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day.
