**"Addressing Disparities in Living Donor Kidney Transplantation in the Latino Community- Multi-Disciplinary, Community-Engaged Website Design and Assessment "**

"Latinos are 1.5 times more likely to have kidney failure, wait longer and are less likely than Caucasians to receive kidney transplants from either deceased or living kidney donors. A multi-disciplinary team with expertise in community health, anthropology, learning sciences and web design used: a) community-engaged approaches to design and b) a multi-center, randomized controlled trial (n=277) to assess the impact of the bilingual website Informate – inform yourself about living kidney donation (Infórmate acerca de la donación de riñón) on knowledge about living kidney donation."
