"Addressing Disparities in Living Donor Kidney
Transplantation in the Latino CommunityMulti-Disciplinary, Community-Engaged Website Design and
Assessment"

"Latinos are 1.5 times more likely to have kidney failure, wait longer and are less likely than Caucasians to receive kidney transplants from either deceased or living kidney donors. A multi-disciplinary team with expertise in community health, anthropology, learning sciences and web design used: a) community-engaged approaches to design and b) a multi-center, randomized controlled trial (n=277) to assess the impact of the bilingual website Informate – inform yourself about living kidney donation (Infórmate acerca de la donación de riñón) on knowledge about living kidney donation."
