

OCT Begins 8/18

The next section of **Online Certification Training (OCT)** will begin on **August 18, 2014**.

OCT is the university's eightweek training program that prepares faculty to teach online. It helps instructors understand what online learning is, how to prepare their course content for an online environment, and what the best practices are for online course development and teaching. It also explores such areas as instructional design, ADA web accessibility guidelines, and internet copyright and fair use. OCT is meant to provide an introductory overview of these topics, and to prepare faculty to meet the requirements of the Illinois Online Network **Ouality Online Course Initia**tive (QOCI) rubric that is used by CSU's Distance Education Committee to review online courses.

OCT takes place completely online via Moodle. Those who successfully meet all of its requirements will be presented with a certificate of completion.
