



Abilities Office Notetaking AI Agreement

Under Section 504 and the Americans with Disabilities Act, institutions of higher education must provide reasonable accommodations for students with documented disabilities. **Genio**, an AI-powered notetaking program, may be used as an accommodation to support learning disabilities.

The **CSU Abilities Office** requires this agreement be signed as an approved classroom aid and reasonable accommodation.

I, *(Student Name)* understand that Genio AI Notetaking Application, and associated recordings of lectures and lecture notes are only to be used for my personal academic needs during the current semester.

By agreeing to this approved accommodation, I understand and accept the following:

- Use of Genio is limited to official class meetings, lectures, and discussions.
- Recordings, notes, flashcards, quizzes, or podcasts generated by Genio are for my personal academic purposes only.
- No copies, in any format, of the recordings or AI-generated materials will be shared, published, or broadcasted.
- I shall not profit from, distribute, or allow others to benefit from the AI-generated notes.
- Instructors may require Genio to be disabled during sensitive content discussions (while maintaining confidentiality).
- The license is subject to reallocation and I may lose access to this accommodation if the application reflects "no data", meaning the application hasn't been used by me.
- I will delete all recordings, notes, and associated materials within 48 hours after the final exam.
- Violation of this agreement may result in disciplinary action under the **Student Code of Conduct** or subject me to liability under copyright laws.
