 - i. Statement regarding Faculty Cue Loads (**Appendix B**)
 - Goss (UPI President) provided a timeline of the statement from
 the Academic Affairs Committee regarding cue loads. It should
 be noted that Senators had not seen the statement because
 Union leadership recommended the drafted statement NOT
 move forward from the Faculty Senate President. Goss
 expressed concern over the process regarding if a faculty
 member's yearlong is denied by administration
 - After ten minutes expired, Gomez motioned to extend discussion by 7 minutes, Dickson seconded > approved by unanimous consent
 - Austin moved for Raynovich to redraft initial statement from the Academic Affairs Committee and have it reviewed by the UPI leadership council prior to submitting to the Provost by EOD December 8, Gomez seconded > motion carried with 4 abstentions

- a. Al-Ghoul motioned for Faculty Senate of Chicago State University demand a cease fire in the Israel/Gaza armed conflict of October 7, 2023, Toth seconded

 - Statement will be drafted by an ad-hoc committee created by Raynovich and submitted to Raynovich by EOD 12/12. Senators must discuss with their colleagues for feedback. Vote will be asynchronous online.
