- 4. RN license verification that verifies current unrestricted RN license to practice in Illinois.
- 5. Meet the university prerequisite requirements for Bachelor Degree criteria as traditional nursing students.
- 1. This application **must be completed** by all students seeking admission to the RN to BSN Program.
- 2. There are **two applications** that must be completed: one to the University Undergraduate Admissions Office and one to the Department of Nursing.

All students in the RN to BSN Completion Program must complete 120 semester hours consisting of general education requirements, nursing prerequisite courses, the 29 hours of the nursing curriculum, and the university credits granted for previous nursing coursework. Students are required to complete university general education and nursing prerequisites prior to beginning the upper division nursing courses. Admission to the RN to BSN Completion Program is competitive and there is a restricted enrollment.
- 4. All admissions to the RN to BSN Curriculum are conditional until verification of the completion of all courses, and copies of your current and unrestricted RN license.
