

AA/AS/GECC University General Education Policy

This policy supersedes and replaces the Fall 2008 policy on General Education/Pre-baccalaureate degrees. It is effective for all students admitted for Fall 2023 semester.

Any student who transfers to CSU with an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science Degree that fully satisfies the Illinois GECC requirements will be deemed to have completed ALL University general education requirements including those University requirements which exceed the Illinois General Education Core Curriculum. This policy does not override the requirements of any College, Department, Program or Major.

Any student who transfers to CSU WITHOUT an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science Degree, but with 75 or more credit hours and has completed the Illinois GECC requirements BEFORE transferring, will be deemed to have completed all University general education requirements including those University requirements which exceed the Illinois General Education Core Curriculum. This policy does not override the requirements of any College, Department, Program or Major.

Any student who transfers to Chicago State University with an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science Degree will not be required to take proficiency examinations in English, Mathematics, or Reading. However, if individual courses in specific majors require a passing score on a proficiency examination as a prerequisite, all students, including transfer students, must satisfy the prerequisite by taking the proficiency examination.

This policy is effective for Fall 2023 admits and forward.
