

Initial Program Assignment

Upon acceptance to Chicago State University, each entering student is assigned an academic career (grad, undergrad, professional, continuing education), program, plan, and academic requirement term, *consistent with the academic major or program of study choices* made by the student. Students are required to follow the academic program/plan requirements in the Academic Catalog in effect at the time of their initial enrollment.

Program/Plan Changes

Students may request to change their academic program/plan at any time. The effective date of the change will be the date processed in the student system. The student's degree audit will immediately reflect the program/plan change, and program requirements will follow the academic catalog for the year that the change is taking place. Students should contact their advisor to discuss the impact of a major change on the time to graduation.

For financial aid processing and certain reporting purposes, any change made to the student's academic program/plan after the tenth day of the term or between terms will take effect on the first day of the next term. Changes to the major or program of study does not impact six-year guaranteed tuition rates as described in the Tuition & Fees section of the catalog
